A broad programme of study operates at Year 9 and Year 10, with more subject specialities at Years 11-13. The senior school curriculum offers NCEA Levels 1 to 3 plus Level 4 Scholarship. In addition, Cambridge AS Levels in English Literature and Mathematics are offered at Year 12 for selected students. Students are given the opportunity to enter the Australian schools English and Science competitions.
